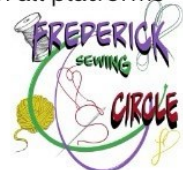

To observe, document and disrupt by any means available the ICE Hold Facility at 3770 Puritan Way, in Frederick, Colorado

INFORMED CONSENT:

We have had 1-6 people at this site 3-6 days a week for at least 4 hours since the beginning of march.

These are ICE ERO agents who do not want us there. They are **men** who **are nervous** about their exposure **and** they are **armed**. There are a few of them who like to try to intimidate and apply pressure to us. They are escalatory and one or two of them have great observational skills. **We have seen their guns 3 times, and had one pointed at an activist one time.**

It is wise to practice blocing. Wear clothing with no logo, a mask or gaiter to hide your face, hats with no logo. Another safety measure is to leave your phone at home, but bring your camera and a notebook. They are also recording us to send in their own signal chats. if you dont want your identity leaked, bloc up! Your safety and comfort level are up to you!

It is recommended for safety purposes that you always bring a buddy, but groups of 3-6 are much more effective at documentation.

The ICE agents will open doors and gates to try to distract. There are 7 points of known entry at this site, plus one garage bay. Unit C is an area of interest as well, which adds 2 points of entry and another garage.

This location has become increasingly busy, especially the hours of 10a-3pm, the 12-2 time frame being the busiest. We do not yet have observations outside of 7a-6p. They are not active on sundays yet and sporadically active on saturdays.

The Fredrick Police Department and Frederick Fire Department are frequently called to run code enforcement on us, including where we park, and where we stand. Although the address is on Puritan, there is no sidewalk on the east side of the building, so we set up on the sidewalk to the south on Eureka. (see map below)

also place a sign or cloth over your plate while you're parked. They haven't left their own vehicle to pull these off **YET**.

ErinGoLightly will post an internal schedule when their group will be out every week. Please feel free to come out and become oriented while they are there. If these times are outside of your availability, feel free to form a direct action partner or group and go!!

REQUESTED BUT NOT REQUIRED:

If you are going to be helping us watch this facility in person, we ask for a couple of data points be placed in the FRDHOLD DAGs chat.

1. time of arrival and how many vehicles are parked at the ice facility. There will be cars parked in the gate and some out front.
2. time of departure and how many vehicles.
3. GEO Transport arrival and departure times.
4. Licence plate photo drops. (this is for a data system)
5. Arrival/departure times with licence plates through your sit. (i do this by taking hand written notes) (helps with an overall pattern of movement)

DRIVE BY'S:

We are also gathering data points by simply driving by the location. If you're driving by I25 & 52, take a 3 minute detour and tell us:

1. Time of drive by and how many vehicles are parked at the ice facility.

OTHER POINTS OF PRESSURE:

We have several different ways we are applying pressure here. My group heckles the agents while documenting. That is absolutely not required or requested. If you're more comfortable with a covert op, do that! If you want to bring 40 people and throw a party, also do that! (just pick up your litter, or else be charged with domestic terrorism).

Another very important way we are applying pressure is research, canvassing, social media, and direct outreach to the community effected. We have compiled a list of contact information, should anyone wish to start a phone campaign.
